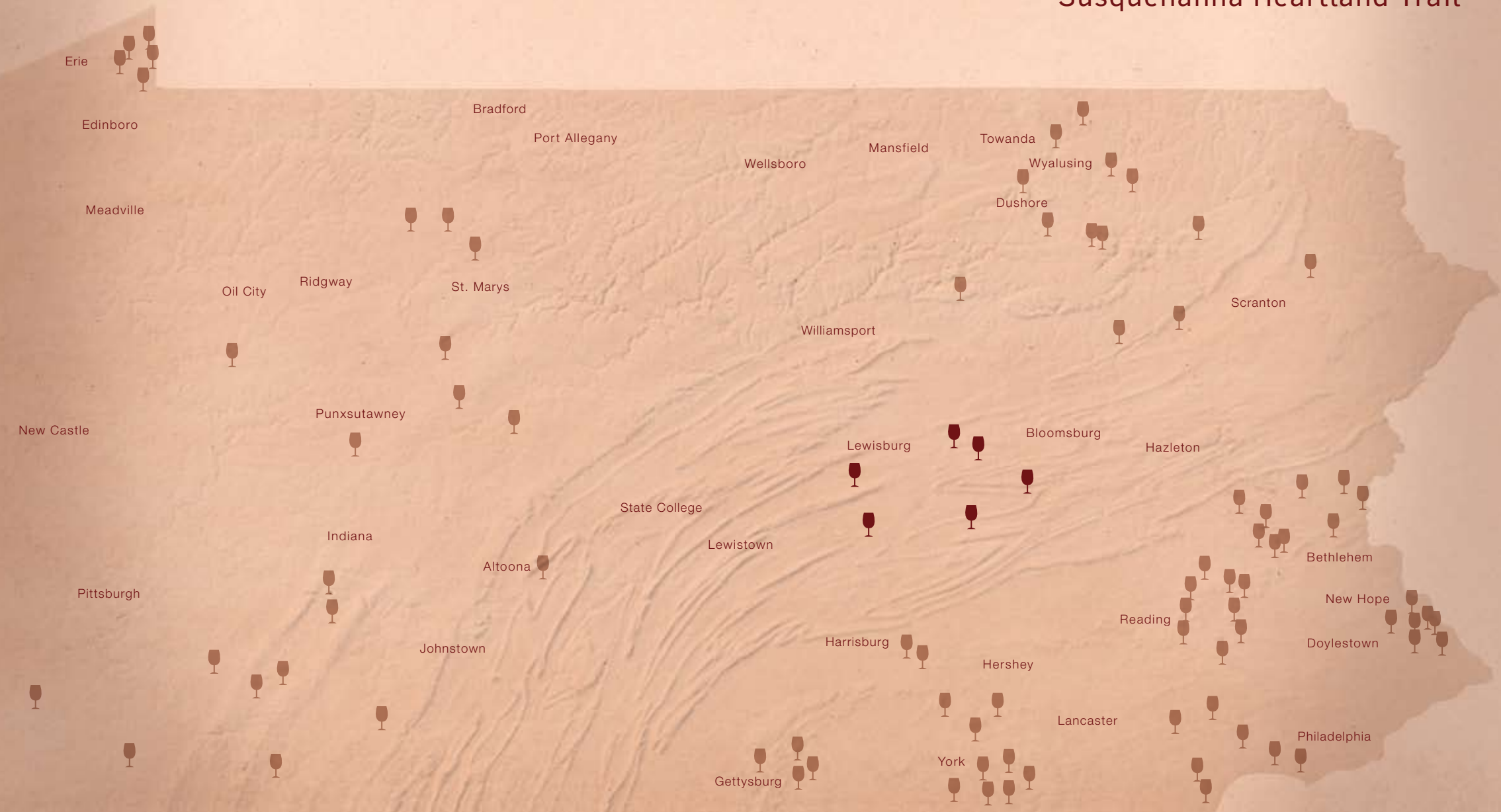


## Susquehanna Heartland Trail
